WELCOME TO TAURANGA WOODCRAFTERS' GUILD

We have special interest woodcrafting groups covering the skills of Carving, Cabinet-making, Intarsia, Marquetry, Scrollsawing, and Woodturning, each meeting regularly. The full Club also meets once a month for activities and demonstrations by the various disciplines, and for wider fellowship among members.

We make Wig-stands for Cancer Patients, & Wooden Toys for the Salvation Army and Hospital each Christmas. We have done Restoration work for Historic Sites like the Elms Mission Station, and the Otumoetai Pa Historic Reserve.

The Major event of our year is our Annual Exhibition, in November, when our finished work is on display for the Public to enjoy along with live displays of some of our crafts in action.
