We are a group of Hobby Woodworkers, keen to share our love of wood and skills with one another, with anyone who would like to join us, and with the community.

Our Club has been active since 1987, & we have approx. 90 members (men & women) of all ages and skill levels. We have a purpose-built Workshop equipped with machinery and hand tools suited to wood crafting & one-off bespoke projects.

Our wood crafting groups cover Carving, Intarsia, Marquetry, Scrollsawing, & Woodturning. Each group has a group coordinator. The full Club meets once a month for activities and demonstrations, and for wider fellowship among members.

New people may attend 2 meetings without needing to pay the subscription fee and join. Once you pay the subscription you may attend as many group meetings as you wish.
