The rod for adjusting the tension on the top pulley needed to be straightened after someone applied too much force. This has now been done. The top guide is away to try and get it welded back together. A new aftermarket guide assembly will be ordered from the USA if this is unsuccessful.



The Guild gave the committee approval at the AGM to replace the Dyco bandsaw with a new 14" machine. Proposals are being sought from suppliers to install a Solar PV system on the roof of the workshop, aiming to reduce our power costs.




